Day Two:

1. Jelly Bean Science

3. Oval Walk
 - (19.A.ECa Engage in active play)
4. Reading Activity: Read for at least 10 minutes.

Day Three:

 - (6.A.ECb Use subitizing)
3. Plastic Easter Egg Name Game
 - (4.B.ECb Recognize and name some letters)
4. Reading Activity: Read for at least 10 minutes.

Day Five:

1. Color Shape Sorting
 - (8.A.ECa Sort, order, compare, and describe simple attributes)
2. Egg Listening Game
 - (30.C.ECd Demonstrate engagement and attention)
3. Color Words
 - (4.A.ECa Recognize differences in print and pictures)
4. Reading Activity: Read for at least 10 minutes.
